### CURRICULUM

<b>INTRO</b>	<p><b>Recap Session #6</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “Can someone remind us what our pitches are to be about?”</li> <li>• “We are making short videos pitching our ideas for projects that would make life better for kids in our school.”</li> <li>• “Before we begin, let’s talk about the potential impact of the project. Why do you think it is important for adults in our school to know about your ideas for making things better?” - <i>kids have a unique perspective, see things that adults don’t, have a better sense of what kids are going through, etc.</i></li> </ul>	5-7 min

<b>NEW IDEAS</b>	<p><b>Project Development</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “Let’s look at some of the lists we generated last session about issues kids face, locations where it is most common, and situations we would like to help with.”</li> <li>• “Let’s now break into small groups. Each small group can come up with a couple ideas of projects based on the concerns we all came up with.”</li> <li>• “For each project idea we want to know (1) What is the issue we are addressing? (2) What do we know about the issue (3) What idea do you have for a project that could help?”</li> <li>• “Now we are going to spend our time putting our ideas together on video. Remember the three questions.”</li> </ul>	TBD
