	<p><b>Preparation for the Celebration</b></p> <p>Why did we choose this organization?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “Let’s work as a group to figure out why we chose this organization. Let’s figure out the top three reasons why we choose them. What do they do? Why are they important? What issue are they workint to solve?”</li> </ul> <p>What questions do we have?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “At the celebration we can ask a question or two. What questions do we have?”</li> </ul> <p>What is our role at the Celebration?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “Let’s talk about the roles we will play at the upcoming Celebration.”</li> </ul>	10 min
