INTRO	<p>Recap Session #5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “What did you like about the Steps to Good game?” • “What would you change about it?” 	5 min
SHARE	<p>How I Help (THINK PAIR SHARE)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Please think about a health challenge that you or someone close to you has had. What was hard about it. What helped you?” • “Now share with a partner.” • “Are there any volunteers who would like to share with the group?” • “What patterns did we notice about what helped or what was hard?” 	10 min
NEW IDEAS	<p>Video Challenge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Our challenge as a group is to come up with a video promoting a non-profit that helps address health challenges that kids face.” • “Let’s start by coming up with a list of possible non-profits to choose for the video.” 	10 min
CLOSING ACTION	<p>Research</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Before we vote on which organization to support, let’s break into groups and do some research. Find their websites, watch some videos, look for ways people can get involved.” • “Now let’s share what we found and then take a vote.” 	15 min
