### CURRICULUM

WARM UP (validate existing knowledge)	<b>What is My Message</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Show students the t-shirts.</li> <li>• Have them write out their message.</li> <li>• Show the Rights of All Visual if needed.</li> </ul>	5 min
NEW IDEAS (introduce and apply new content)	<b>What Matters to Me T-shirts</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Help students make t-shirts with their messages on them. Examples could include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Protecting the earth</li> <li>◦ Homelessness</li> <li>◦ Kids having love</li> <li>◦ The end of bullying, etc.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	25 min
